LEGAL METROLOGY ACT, 2009.

No. GTH/2025/14/FCSCAD/CLM/e-file/5/2023/2144/D:- WHEREAS certain draft rules were published as required by sub-section (4) of section 53 of Legal Metrology Act, 2009 (1 of 2010), at pages 133 to 138 in the Gujarat Government Gazette, Ordinary Part IV-A dated the 27th March, 2025, under the Government Notification, Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Department, No. GTH/2025/7/FCSCAD/CLM/e-file/5/2023/2144/D, dated the 18th March, 2025 inviting objection or suggestion from all persons likely to be affected thereby within a period of thirty days from the date of publication of the said notification in the *Official Gazette*.

AND WHEREAS, no objections or suggestions have been received by the Government in respect of the said draft rules;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 53, read with clause (f) of sub-section (2) of section 53 of the Legal Metrology Act, 2009 (1 of 2010) and after consultation with the Central Government, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules, further to amend the Gujarat Legal Metrology (Enforcement) Rules, 2011 namely: -

- 1. (1) These rules may be called the Gujarat Legal Metrology (Enforcement) (Amendment) Rules, 2025.
 - (2) They extend to the whole of the State of Gujarat.
 - (3) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the *Official Gazette*.

2. In the Gujarat Legal Metrology (Enforcement) Rules, 2011, for Schedule - XI, the following Schedule shall be substituted, namely: -

No.GG/97/PST/102025/376/C:- WHEREAS the Government of Gujarat had vide Notification No. GG/62/TTC/12007-UO-1-V, dated the 1st October, 2015, declared GUVNL Police Stations of respective district for the purpose of registering offences and investigate the crimes under sections 135, 138 to 141 and 150 of the Electricity Act, 2003, for the jurisdiction of all installations of the respective Government Companies and the Torrent Power Limited situated in Surat City, Surat Rural District, Ahmedabad City, Ahmedabad Rural District and Gandhinagar District;

AND WHEREAS the Government has decided to declare separate police stations in respect of the offences under Electricity Act, 2003 for the respective areas of the Torrent Power Limited;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (u) of sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023(46 of 2023) in its application to the State of Gujarat, the Government of Gujarat hereby declares the post and places specified in column (4) of the Schedule appended hereto, to be the Police Station in the divisions specified in column (2) and directs that each of such Police Stations shall include such Police Chowky(s) or Beat or Zone, Out Post or Operational Area and Local Areas or Villages, as are respectively specified against each of the said Police Stations in columns (5), (6) and (7) of the said Schedule for the purposes of assisting in gathering information about theft of electricity and property, provide protection during installation, checking carried out for detection of theft and/or unauthorized use of electricity, and for register and investigate the offences under sections 135, 138 to 141 and 150 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (36 of 2003) in respect of theft of electricity, as follows, namely:-

No.-GL/07/SJED/EOD/e-file/17/2025/1172/CHH Section:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Joint Director, Class I, in the General State Service of the Directorate of Social Defence, Gujarat State, namely:-

- 1. (1) These rules may be called the Joint Director, Class I, in the General State Service of the Directorate of Social Defence, Recruitment Rules, 2025.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Official Gazette*.
- 2. Appointment to the post of Joint Director, Class I, in the General State Service of the Directorate of Social Defence, Gujarat State shall be made by promotion of a person who possesses 'very good' benchmark for being considered fit for promotion within zone of consideration as laid down in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967; from amongst the persons, who, -
 - (a) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Deputy Director, Class I, in the General State Service of the Directorate of Social Defence, Gujarat State, and
 - (b) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience as specified in clause (a) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-third of the period specified clause (a) above.

3. The candidate appointed by promotion shall be required to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.

CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No.GL/12/2025/SJED/MISC/e-file/17/2023/2950/CHH:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating the conditions of service of persons appointed to the post of Probation Officer, Class III, in the Directorate of Social Defence, Gujarat State, in so far as they relate to the passing of departmental examination to be eligible for promotion to the post of Chief Officer, Class III, in the Directorate of Social Defence, namely:-

1. Short title, commencement and extent:-

- (1) These rules may be called the Chief Officer, Class III, in the Directorate of Social Defence (Departmental Examination) Rules, 2025.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Official Gazette*.
- (3) They shall apply to persons appointed as Probation Officer, Class III, in the Directorate of Social Defence Department by direct selection.

2. Definitions.

In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires -

- (a) "Appendix" means an appendix appended to these rules;
- (b) "Appointed Date" means the date on which these rules come into force;
- (c) "Board" means the Gujarat Subordinate Services Selection Board;
- (d) "Examination" means the departmental examination for the promotion to the post of Chief Officer, Class III, in the Directorate of Social Defence;
- (e) "Direct Recruite" means a person appointed as Probation Officer, Class III in the Directorate of Social Defence:
- (f) "Government" means the Government of Gujarat;
- (g) "Old rules" means the rules in force immediately before the appointed date;
- (h) "Prescribed" means prescribed by the regulations made by the Board;
- (i) "Relevant departmental examination" means the departmental examination specified under the relevant old rule;
- (j) "Specified chance" means the number of chances specified in these rules within which a person is required to pass the departmental examination;
- (k) "Specified period" means the period specified in these rules within which a person is required to pass the departmental examination.

3. Requirement to pass the Departmental Examination,-

The person appointed to the post of Probation Officer, Class III, in the Directorate of Social Defence shall be required to pass the examination to be eligible for promotion to the post of Chief Officer, Class III, in the Directorate of Social Defence:

Provided that where any person who has been exempted from passing the relevant departmental examination under the old rules before the appointed date, such person shall not be required to pass the departmental examination under these rules.

4. Eligibility to appear in the examination,-

- (1) No person shall be eligible to appear the examination unless he has completed two years' service after his appointment on the post of Probation Officer in the Directorate of Social Defence;
- (2) No person shall be eligible to appear the examination unless he has passed the post-training examination for the post of Probation Officer, Class III, in the Directorate of Social Defence.

5. Specified chances and period for passing the Examination,-

(1) To be eligible for promotion to the post of Chief Officer, Class III, in the Directorate of Social Defence, a person shall be required to pass examination, within a period of three years and within three chances from the date of his completing two years' continuous service after his appointment on the respective post in the Probation Officer, Class III, in the Directorate of Social Defence or has been exempted from passing the relevant departmental examination:

Provided that a person belonging to the Schedule Caste or Schedule Tribe may be given one additional chance which shall have to be availed of within a period of one year from the date of declaration of the result of the examination of his third chance;

Provided further that the chances for passing the relevant Departmental Examination shall be deemed to have been provided under these rules and a person who has been provided any chance under the old rules shall be allowed to avail the remaining chances under these rules:

Provided also that where the period of passing the examination expire before providing the person the chances available to him under these rules, the said period shall be deemed to have been extended up to the result of the Examination.

(2) If a person fails to pass the examination referred to in these rules within the specified period and within the specified chances, he shall notwithstanding such failure, be eligible to appear at any time in the examination on payment of an examination fees as may be determined by the Government from time to time in this behalf and on passing such examination, he shall be eligible for promotion:

Provided that a person shall not be entitled to claim seniority over those persons who have passed the examination earlier than him and also have been promoted before he became eligible for such promotion on passing such examination after specified chances;

(3) Not appearing in the examination shall be considered as a chance.

6. Syllabus and scheme of examination: -

- (i) The syllabus for examination shall be as specified in the Appendix-"A".
- (ii) The examination shall consist of five papers each of 100 (One hundred) marks.
- (iii) The Candidate shall be allowed to answer the questions of papers I to III and V with the help of books, whereas, paper IV shall be without books.
 - Explanation: "with books" means original book of the subjects approved by the Government or Board having bare Acts/or Rules without any commentaries or case laws and includes manuals issued under the Act published by the Government.
- (iv) Answers in paper IV shall be required to be written in English or Gujarati, as per the instructions given in the question paper.
- (v) Paper I, II, III and V shall be objective type and PaperIV shall be Descriptive type.

7. Medium of examination:- The medium of the examination shall be Gujarati or English as per instructions, given in the question paper.

8. Holding of examination,-

- (1) The Board shall hold the examination at least twice in a year;
- (2) The Board shall communicate the tentative programme of examination to the Social Justice and Empowerment Department and office of the Director of Social Defence at least ninety days before the provisional date prescribed by the Board.
- (3) A person who desires to appear in the examination shall be required to send his application in the form as specified in "APPENDIX" B to the Board through the Director of Social Defence for enlisting his name as a candidate for such examination at least sixty days prior to date of the examination.
- (4) The Director of Social Defence shall scrutinise his application with regard to his eligibility for appearing in the examination and forward the same to the Board with the Certificate of Eligibility as specified in the "APPENDIX" C.
- (5) If the applicant subsequently decides not to appear in the examination, he shall give intimation thereof to the Board through the Director of Social Defence at least thirty days before the date of commencement of the examination;
- (6) If any person fails to appear in the examination after having enlisted his name as a candidate without giving intimation as referred in sub-rule (5), he shall be deemed to have lost one chance to pass the examination;
- (7) The Board shall admit the candidate to the examination on the strength of the certificate issued by the Director of Social Defence that he is eligible to appear in the examination:

Provided that the Director of Social Defence may condone the failure on the part of the person to give intimation referred in sub-rule (5) and the consequences arising there from, if it is satisfied that the person has failed to give intimation within time for reasons beyond his control;

(8) The place, date and time for holding the examination shall be communicated by the Board and the same shall be communicated to the candidates by the Director of Social Defence.

9. The Standard for passing the examination,-

- (1) The standard for passing the examination shall be fifty percent (50%) of the total marks assigned to each paper;
- (2) An unsuccessful candidate who secures fifty percent (50%) or more marks in any one or more papers shall be exempted from appearing in those papers in the subsequent examination;
- (3) In case a candidate is not able to obtain the qualifying standard in only one paper in the examination, such candidate shall be given grace marks up to 5% of the total marks for that paper and thereafter if he obtains the marks equal or more than qualifying standard, he shall be declared pass.

10. Publication of result,-

The Board shall publish the result of the examination on its official website and shall also forward the same to the Office of the Director of Social Defence under the intimation of the Social Justice and Empowerment Department. The Director of Social Defence shall intimate the result to the candidates.

11. Prohibition to use certain devices in the examination hall,-

No candidate shall be allowed to carry with him any electronic communication devices like cellular phone, calculator, pager, i-pad etc. in the examination hall.

12. Repeal and Saving,-

The old rules made for examination for promotion to the post of Chief Officer, Class III, in the Directorate of Social Defence and any other rules corresponding thereto in force immediately before the coming into force of these rules are hereby repealed:

Provided that such repeal shall not affect anything done or action taken under any of the rules, so repealed.
